

## TRANSPORTATION FROM LOGAN AIRPORT TO CHESTNUT HILL BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION

Following are transportation options for arriving at the BA. Confirm rates and terms (they may change) when communicating with the carriers.

When arriving at Central Reception, an elevator is located about 30 feet to the left of the main entrance steps. You may enter the building, with your luggage, via this elevator or the front steps. Instructions are posted on the lift for entry to the first floor.

### Option #1: TAXI

- Direct the driver to 910 Boylston Street (Route 9) in Chestnut Hill which is a part of the township of Brookline.)
- Estimated fare from the airport is \$60 - \$70; from Back Bay Station \$33 - \$40; from The Mother Church area \$25; from the Chestnut Hill MBTA (“T”) stop, \$6.
- The phone for Brookline Red Cab/Bay State, our local company, is 617-734-5000, but from the airport you may take any taxi parked at your terminal.

Directions are as follows:

#### **From Boston: (Mother Church Area)**

- Route 9 (starts as Huntington Avenue), borders Christian Science Plaza on the south side, takes you WEST all the way to the BA (about 4 miles).
- The BA is on the left side of Route 9 (now Boylston Street). Approach the BA, you come upon a break in the median and a left hand turn lane. From the turn lane turn left into the property when eastbound traffic allows you to cross.
- Go up the hill. A sign directs left to Central Reception or right to the Christian Science Nursing Building.

#### **From Logan Airport:**

- The BA is ten miles west of the airport. Take the Ted Williams Tunnel to the Massachusetts Turnpike, get off at Exit 17. Get in the left lane of the two-lane ramp and follow signs to Newton Center, basically continuing straight ahead for two blocks, then turning left for a U turn over the Turnpike.
- Move to the right lane for a right turn at the traffic light onto Centre Street. Proceed two miles and take a left onto Beacon Street. At next traffic light on Beacon, turn right onto Langley Road.

- Go one mile and take Route 9 EAST. At the Hammond Street stoplight (note a CVS Pharmacy on the left and an Exxon Station just beyond the light on the right), you are within 1/2 mile of the BA.
- Continue on Route 9 and take a right at the BA entrance. As you go up the hill, a sign directs you left to Central Reception (for Rest & Study, Residential, and Administration) or right to the Christian Science Nursing Building.

## **Option #2: PRIVATE CARRIERS**

Following is information on private carriers used by BA guests on a regular basis.

### **Brookline Coach.**

- Brookline Coach regrets to inform its friends and customers that it is no longer in business. They send their thanks for the patronage the BA and its guests have given them throughout the years.

### **C Sar Exclusive Ride.**

- One way fare \$50, which includes all taxes and tolls. Suggested gratuity is 15%
- Payment to be made by check or cash.

- Sedans - like Lincoln Town Cars, which fit 3 to 4 passengers and about 4 or 5 pieces of luggage max. Great for 1 or 2 passengers. Trips are non-stop unless requested by the customer. They are open for early morning and late night pick-up at Logan.
- Reservation required.

### **Gray Van Express.**

- One way fare from Logan Airport: \$35.
- Additional \$5 fee for tolls going into Logan. These charges include all taxes. Gratuity not included.
- Extra charge for additional passenger going to the same address: \$10.
- Phone: 888-308-9717.
- Reservation required.

### **Trademark Livery**

- One way fare to/from Logan Airport: \$55.00, all tolls included. Gratuity not included.
- Cadillac sedans that fit a maximum of 4 passengers and 5 pieces of luggage.
- All major credit cards, checks or cash.
- Services available 24/7 and would like a day's notice for reservation.

### Ultimate Livery.

- One way fare: \$34, per person (subject to change).
- This service makes a maximum of 3 stops on each trip.

- Reservation required (24 hours ahead. When calling, specify “Chestnut Hill Benevolent Association” as your destination

**Option #3: SUBWAY/TRAIN.** Fares and other information can be accessed toll-free at 800-392-6100 or at website [www.mbta.com](http://www.mbta.com).

### Chestnut Hill T-Stop

- The BA is 7/10 mile from Chestnut Hill MBTA Station on the “D Riverside” branch of the Green Line.
- There are no public pay phones. From the station you may (1) taxi [617-734-5000], (2) call the BA [800-662-9937] for a ride, or (3) walk (not recommended if you have luggage due to hills).

### Walking From T-Stop

- Cross both sets of tracks away from the parking lot and follow the path to the left of the passenger shelters.
- Continue until it ends at Middlesex Road. Cross Middlesex onto Dunster Road, proceeding until it ends at Route 9 (Boylston Street).
- Staying on the same side of Route 9, take a left and proceed two blocks to a pedestrian traffic light across from the BA.
- Use the light for crossing four traffic lanes. The BA entrance will be very visible. As you proceed up the hill, a sign will direct you left to Central Reception (for Rest & Study, Residential, and Administration) or right to the Christian Science Nursing Building.

### **From Logan Airport to Chestnut Hill Station.**

- Take a free shuttle from any terminal to the Airport MBTA Station on the Blue Line. Take any INBOUND train to Government Center Station and take a “D Riverside” train on the Green Line INBOUND. Chestnut Hill Station is 13 stops away.

### **From Mother Church Area to Chestnut Hill Station.**

- Hynes Convention Center Station on the Green Line is two blocks north of The Mother Church near the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Boylston Street. From there, take any OUTBOUND train designated “D Riverside.” Chestnut Hill Station is 8 stops away.

**Option #4: SUBWAY/BUS.** Fares and other information can be accessed toll-free at 800-392-6100 or at website [www.mbta.com](http://www.mbta.com).

The bus lets you off opposite the entrance to the BA. Once off the bus, use the pedestrian traffic light to cross the four-lane road. The BA entrance will be very visible. On the grounds, a sign will direct you left to Central Reception (for Rest & Study, Residential, and Administration) or right to the Christian Science Nursing Building.

**From Logan Airport to Subway/Bus.**

- Take a free shuttle from any terminal to the Airport MBTA Station on the Blue Line.
- At the station, take any INBOUND train to Government Center Station where you should disembark and take any INBOUND Green Line train, except those marked “E”.
- Get off at Kenmore Station and proceed to the street level bus area.
- Take the #60 Bus. Let the driver know that you will be getting off opposite 910 Boylston Street in Chestnut Hill.
- Once off the bus, use the pedestrian traffic light to cross the four-lane road. The BA entrance will be very visible. Proceeding up the hill, a sign will direct you left to Central Reception (for Rest & Study, Residential, and Administration) or right to the Christian Science Nursing Building.

**From Mother Church Area to Subway/Bus.**

- Hynes Convention Center Station on the Green Line is two blocks north of The Mother Church near the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Boylston Street.
- From there, take any OUTBOUND train one stop to Kenmore Station.
- Proceed to the street level bus area and take a #60 Bus.
- Let the driver know that you will be getting off opposite 910 Boylston Street in Chestnut Hill.
- Once off the bus, use the pedestrian traffic light to cross the four-lane road. The BA entrance will be very visible. Proceeding up the hill, a sign will direct you left to Central Reception (for Rest & Study, Residential, and Administration) or right to the Christian Science Nursing Building.
